CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: Winter Quarter 2018

MONDAY

Leadership (4+) (A) 3:00-4:00

In this class, our 4th-5th graders will be doing team builders and learning how to be a leader at Kids U.

Camp Crafts (A) 3:00-4:00

We will be bringing in the classics from summer - from lanyards and fortune tellers, to tie dye and more!

Playground Games (A) 3:00-4:00

Zombie Tag, 4 Square, and kick the can are only some of the games we will be exploring in this class. We will keep the kids active and moving while we play fun teambuilding games!

Music 101 (B) 4:00-5:00

Students will get to learn music basics in this class. We will be listening to music, playing our own, and even making our own instruments! Different areas of music theory will be explored in age-appropriate interactive projects and activities!

Game On! (C) 4:00-5:00

Get your game on! We will be exploring a new type of game each week! From active games, to board games, to quiet games, if you like games, this class is for you!

Fuse Beads (C) 5:00-6:00

Those tiny little beads create hours of creative fun. Use a template, or create your own unique design to melt into a lasting memory.

Think Tank (C) 5:00-6:00

Designed for those who have homework to complete, or enjoy challenging themselves by completing grade level worksheets, brain games, or reading time.

TUESDAY

Around the World: Dance (A) 3:00-4:00

Travel around the world with kids U though the art of dance! Each week we will be exploring a new culture by moving our feet, listening to music, and having FUN!

Mountaineers (3rd+)* (A&B) 3:00-5:00

We will be partnering with the Mountaineers for this fun and exciting class. Our 3rd-5th graders will get to climb on the climbing wall, learn how to belay, and repel! Limit to 12 kids. \$220/FM \$236/CM

Painters Workshop (A) 3:00-4:00

Students will create painted masterpieces in this class of a variety of subjects and topics. Each week, a new theme will be explored while we use water colors, tempura, finger paint, and so much more.

Let's Make a Movie (B) 4:00-5:00

Ready...and...ACTION! Students will get to explore set building, acting, and movie making. At the end of the class students will get to come home with a short film that they created!

Comic Book Club (B) 4:00-5:00

Comic books are a great way to explore illustration, character development, and plot! We will be reading some classics as well as making our very own comic book!

Duct Tape Art (C) 5:00-6:00

This handy house hold item can make beautiful works of art! We will be using fun colors and patterns to make things like flowers, wallets, bookmarks, and more!

Think Tank (C) 5:00-6:00

Designed for those who have homework to complete, or enjoy challenging themselves by completing grade level worksheets, brain games, or reading time.

WEDNESDAY

Strings and Things (3+) (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Friendship bracelets, finger knitting, lanyards, and more! In this class students will create all kinds of stringy creations that they can take home and share!

Art with Heart (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Each week students will be creating a work of art with a purpose - giving it to someone in need! We will be making cards for local organizations, heroes, and more!

Tag Extravaganza! (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Tag! You're it! In this class we will be exploring a new tag game each week focusing on team building, sportsmanship, and fun!

3D Art (3+) (A) 3:00-4:00

We will be taking our projects off the paper and into the third dimension in this class. Using mediums like fuse beads and origami we will be making three dimensional art of all sorts!

Kids U Architects (A) 3:00-4:00

Get out your rulers and your pencils, its time to design! In this class kids will get to design and build their very own spaces!

Dodgeball (A) 3:00-4:00

This game is perfect for our indoor gym space. We will play a new variation of dodgeball each week with our soft gator skin balls.

Messy Madness (B) 4:00-5:00

Our instructors aren't afraid of glitter or glue! In this class we will explore the world through messy, interactive art projects. This hands-on class will allow children to explore different mediums through sensory education.

Aviation (B) 4:00-5:00

Liftoff! In this class we will be learning the science behind paper airplanes. Students will create new paper airplane models each week and put them to the test in a variety of competitions and trials. A mix of math, and a mix of creativity will be explored while having FUN!

Pipe Cleaner Art (C) 5:00-6:00

The possibilities are endless with fuzzy pipe cleaners! We will be creating a new project each week for students to take home!

Think Tank (C) 5:00-6:00

Designed for those who have homework to complete, or enjoy challenging themselves by completing grade level worksheets, brain games, and reading time.

THURSDAY

Kindergarten Fun Bunch (A) 3:00-4:00

In this class Kindergarteners will learn the ropes at Kids U! We will be getting to know each other and the space through interactive, age-appropriate games and projects.

Ancient Civilizations (A) 3:00-4:00

Dive into the history books with this class! We will be learning about a new ancient civilization each week, exploring how they lived, what they ate, and so much more.

Capture the Flag (A) 3:00-4:00

This timeless game is a Kid's U favorite! We will be exploring a new variation every week while focusing on strategy, teamwork, and leadership!

Dungeons and Dragons (3+) (B) 4:00-5:00

Travel with us on a grand quest. Our instructors have created a Kids U specific campaign in this fun tabletop role playing game.

Zentangle (B) 4:00-5:00

Do you zentangle, or want to learn how? Zentangle is described as "artistic meditation."

It is a method of creating beautiful and really cool images by drawing structured patterns.

Mind Benders (C) 5:00-6:00

Tounge Twisters, Riddles, word games, and more! Each week we will end the day with a new brain teaser based on language and rhetoric skills that the kids can take home and play on you!

Think Tank (C) 5:00-6:00

Designed for those who have homework to complete, or enjoy challenging themselves by completing grade level worksheets, brain games, and reading time.

FRIDAY

Sports of all Sorts (A) 3:00-4:00

Baseball, Dodgeball, Football and more! Students will explore a new ball game each week. Teamwork and sportsmanship will be a focus.

Bug Out (A) 3:00-4:00

Do you love bugs? This class is for you! We will be bug hunting, creating creepy crawly art projects, and much much more.

Super Scientists (3+) (A) 3:00-4:00

In this class, students will be exploring the world of science, technology, mathematics, engineering, and more!

Building Boom (B) 4:00-5:00

Using building materials of all sorts, students will get to build and create innovative projects! From Legos, to popsicle sticks, to marshmallows there is no limit to what we can create!

Board Game Creation (B) 4:00-5:00

Students will get to explore a variety of different board games in this class. We will be focusing on different aspects of board game design to build their own game to play and take home!
