### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: Winter Quarter 2016/2017

#### MONDAY

##### Camp Crafts (A) 2:45-4:00

Calling all aspiring artists and avid doodlers! Do you love to draw? This class will teach the basics of drawing and use different mediums and help students improve their skills. Open to all grade and experience levels.

Playing card games is a great way for children to learn a variety of skills, including math, taking turns, basic strategy, and being a good sport. Participants will play new card games as well as some of their old favorites.

Play a variety of games in this fun class! We will play all of the favorite gym games, circle games, board games, and more! Students will be encouraged to share, teach, and create new fun games!
