CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: Late Spring Quarter 2018

MONDAY

Sports Around the World (A) 3:00-4:00

Fuse Beads (C) 5:00-6:00

Those tiny little beads create hours of creative fun. Use a template, or create your own unique design to melt into a lasting memory.

WEDNESDAY

Music Games (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Its time to get your dance shoes out with some musical games. Kids will get to move around while listening to and learning about music.

Space Explorers (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Do you love all things space? In this class students will explore the unknown through interactive projects about stars, space travel, planets, black holes, and much much more.

Jump Rope Club (A.1) 2:00-2:45

Jumping rope is a wonderful lifetime fitness activity. Join us as we learn and practice single rope skills, partner routines, double dutch jumping, group games, and more! All ages and skill levels welcome.

Comic Book Club (A) 3:00-4:00

Comic books are a great way to explore illustration, character development, and plot! We will be reading some classics as well as making our very own comic book!

Advanced Origami (A) 3:00-4:00

Love Origami? Want to learn more? In this class we will be taking the paper folding up a notch and performing more advanced folds and culminating projects. Some origami knowledge required.

Teamwork Dreamwork (A) 3:00-4:00

Liftoff! In this class we will be learning the science behind paper airplanes. Students will create new paper airplane models each week and put them to the test in a variety of competitions and trials. A mix of math, and a mix of creativity will be explored while having FUN!

Circle Games (C) 5:00-6:00

Frogger, Pattern Detective, Silent Ball, and MORE! We will be playing new and old favorites each week.

Think Tank (C) 5:00-6:00

Designed for those who have homework to complete, or enjoy challenging themselves by completing grade level worksheets, brain games, and reading time.

THURSDAY

Dungeons & Dragons (A) 3:00-4:00

Travel with us on a grand quest. Our instructors have created a Kids U specific campaign in this fun tabletop role playing game.

Artist Showcase (A) 3:00-4:00

Each week, kids will be exploring a new famous artist and emulating their work. All different mediums and eras will be explored.

FRIDAY

Each week, kids will be presented with a different building challenge, and they will race against the clock to complete it! Different topics on design and engineering will be explored each class.

Character Creation (B) 4:00-5:00

In this class, we will be highlighting characters from our favorite books, movies, and TV shows. We will be exploring character content, costumes, and get to create our own character versions and more!
