



Dear Snoqualmie Elementary School Families:

I am excited to announce that the Snoqualmie YMCA will be at Snoqualmie Elementary for the 2018-19 school year. That is right, no more taking the bus in the afternoon to the Y, the Y will come to us! Paper registration is NOW OPEN! Just fill out the attached form and send it back to us via email at eastsidechildcare@seattleyymca.org or drop it off at the Y (please do not return to the school). Online registration opens June 15th. Please read below for important information on how to register and be added to the info list for online registration.

Enrichment Pass: If you want to register for enrichment 5 days a week from dismissal until 6:00, this is the plan for you. For a monthly fee, your child can attend Kids University every day and choose different classes in each of our 5 sessions. Sessions last about 7-9 weeks and have tons of great enrichment classes to choose from. Sign up once and you are good to go for the whole school year!

Each session you will receive an email with class options for you to choose. See the attached schedule for the first mini session.

Before School (*offered at the Snoqualmie YMCA with bussing to SES*). Looking for before school programming? Email us directly and we will register your child for the program, eastsidechildcare@seattleyymca.org. *Please be sure to include your child's name, birthdate, and school. Only offered for 5 days a week.*

By Class: If you don't need your child to attend Kids U every day, but just want a few enrichment classes, this is the best option for your family. We offer classes in one hour slots and you only attend the classes you choose to attend. You will register for the session and choose if you want to go for one hour per week, 3 full days, or any combination that works with your family's schedule. Your family will re-register each session, so if your needs change that is no problem.

No School Days: Registration opens in September. Need your child to be engaged and having fun when school is closed? The Y has you covered. We offer programming for children Kindergarten-5th grade from 7:00am-6:00pm on day's school is closed. Drop your child off at the Y and feel good leaving them in safe hands and knowing they will have a day full of fun and excitement.

- I understand that the YMCA membership and programs are continuous and that monthly charges or debits, as indicated above, will continue until I give written notice to change or terminate the membership or program.
• I understand any custody agreements involving division of program costs are solely between the legal parties involved and are outside the Payment Agreement made with the YMCA of Greater Seattle.
• I understand that I must give the YMCA written notice (in person or by email ONLY) 30 days prior to the next scheduled draft to change or cancel my membership or program fees. Failure to do so will make the subsequent draft non-refundable. Any outstanding balances will be due at the time of cancellation. I am liable for any fees that the YMCA may incur in its effort to collect any remaining balance due
• I understand that I must inform the YMCA 14 days in advance of any changes to my name, address, telephone number or payment information. Failure to provide the YMCA with current information may result in non-refundable fees and that I am personally responsible for any payments not processed by my financial institution and/or the YMCA
• I understand that the YMCA will notify me at least 30 days in advance of any increase to my monthly membership dues or program fees.
• I understand that it is my responsibility to bring any billing discrepancies to the YMCA's attention within 60 days after they first appear on my financial statements. After 60 days, I waive my right to dispute such discrepancies.
• I understand and authorize that NSF or collection of fees will be charged to me for any declined or returned monthly dues. Such non-sufficient fees will be the maximum amount allowed by law and will include applicable taxes.
